Funeral of Joseph A. Laragy.

The funeral of Joseph A. Laragy, a former member of the Rochester Fire Department, who died Monday in Hahnemann Hospital, took place yesterday morning at 8:30 o'clock from the home of his brother, Norman Laragy, at 316 Murray Street and at 9 o'clock from Holy Apostles Church. Requiem mass was celebrated by Rev. John Smith, Rev. John T. Brophy of St. Monica's Church was present in the sanctuary. Battalion Chief Hugh Smith and a detail of men from the Fire Department were present at the service. Burial was made in Holy Sepulcher Cemetery. The blessing at the grave was made by Rev. John McMahon.
