

***LARAGY, JAMES R.**, 251 Magnolia St., Rochester, N. Y. Born, Rochester, N. Y. Entered the service at Rochester, N. Y., April 4, 1918, at the age of 22 years, as Private, assigned to the 153d Depot, Brigade. Transferred to Company M, 310th Infantry, April 25, 1918; Machine Gun Company, 310th Infantry, May 6, 1918, 78th Division. Trained, Camp Dix, Wrightstown, N. J. Served overseas from May 19, 1918 to May 23, 1919. In action, St. Mihiel; Limey Sector; Meuse-Argonne Offensive. Discharged, May 30, 1919. Died, July 29, 1922, at Rochester, N. Y. Place of burial not reported.

Laragy, John Anthony, 251 Magnolia St., Rochester, N. Y. Entered the service at Rochester, N. Y., May 23, 1917, at the age of 20 years, in Philadelphia, Pa., July 1, 1917; Naval Hospital, Philadelphia, Pa., to July 26, 1917; Receiving Ship, Philadelphia, Pa., to Oct. 16, 1917; U. S. S. DeKalb, to Dec. 4, 1917; Portsmouth, N. H., to Nov. 11, 1918. Fireman 3rd Class. Discharged, Aug. 18, 1919.

Laragy, Joseph Aloysius, 251 Magnolia St., Rochester, N. Y. Entered the service at Buffalo, N. Y., April 22, 1918, at the age of 19 years, in U. S. Naval Reserve Force. Served, Naval Training Station, Great Lakes, Ill., from Aug. 16 1918 to Nov. 11, 1918. Seaman, 2d Class, 145 days; Fireman, 3d Class, 58 days. Released from active duty, March 6, 1919.
